APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of September 9, 2025, meeting were approved. The motion was made to approve minutes by Tom Lindenman and seconded by Gail Figg.

NEW BUSINESS

1. September Month Ending Reports reviewed and as of September 30, we've used 75% of the budget.
2. The 2026 budget was presented at last month's meeting and there were no objections presented within the seven days following. The motion to adopt the 2026 budget was made by Gail Figg and seconded by Tom Lindenman and was passed.

OLD BUSINESS

1. The Feasibility Study is completed, and they will be preparing the report to present.
2. Engine 41 has been sold but we have yet to receive the bill for the advertising of it. Once that is received and paid, all will be complete.
3. There was a meeting held Friday, October 10, regarding the formation of a new Clay/Penn/Centre territory.
4. The Capital Needs list was reviewed. We're in the process of getting three quotes on a new generator. There has been a total of \$130,004.52 purchases received and \$24,684.33 ordered but not yet received.

FIRE CHIEF REPORT

1. First Due is in the process of mapping the fire hydrants. It is continually being updated.
2. There were 70 runs in September and 820 YTD.
3. The Fire Law Best Practices System is not as expected and is considering making a change.
4. Squad 42 required some maintenance.
5. We have three new personnel that are on rotating shifts every 30 days and will be evaluated for each shift.
6. All grants are on hold for now due to the Government shutdown.
7. The hearing for Chris Haggerty is still in continuance. He has filed for unemployment.

OTHER REPORTS

1. The Union representative has been trying to get some questions answered from Nolt Insurance. He also brought the concern of how to get the required training done for the firefighters.
